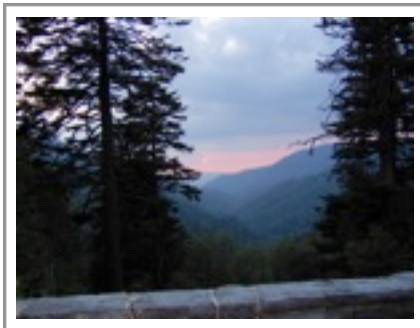

Intermediate Crochet

Thursdays February 9, 16, 23, March 1 7:00 pm
Add some spice to your crocheting! You'll learn to do cables, bobbles and cluster stitches, filet, working with 2 colors, and reverse crochet. You must know how to do basic crochet stitches. Cost: \$55.00 (includes all materials)

Beginning Knitting

Painting Terms:

Base coat: Cover an area of sealed wood with one color before adding other colors
Floating: A way to add shading

1. Dip the flat brush in clean water and lightly blot on paper towel.
2. Dip one corner of the brush in the paint and stroke it on the palette paper.
3. Stroke the brush on the surface with the paint on the outside edge of whatever line you want shaded.

Comma: Touch the tip to the surface, press down and pull to the left or right. Lift the brush and release the pressure gradually, ending on the tip.

C-stroke: Touch the chisel edge to the surface. Apply pressure as you pull the brush toward you in a C-shape. Lift the brush and end with the bristles on the chisel edge.

S-stroke: Start out on the chisel edge. Depending on the direction you need, pull the brush to the right or left while applying pressure. Reduce the pressure and slowly bring the brush back onto the chisel edge.

St. Patrick's Day Pin

You don't have to be Irish to celebrate the "wearing of the green"!



MATERIALS NEEDED:

- three 1 1/2" wooden hearts
- one 1" wooden heart
- Americana acrylic paints by Deco Art: Mistletoe green, Hauser dark green, Titanium white

- Gloss acrylic sealer/finish
- one 7 mm green flat-backed acrylic stone
- 6" of 1/4" forest green double-faced satin ribbon
- 1" pin back
- #8 flat brush
- Stylus
- E6000 glue
- Water
- Sandpaper
- Paper towels

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Coat the hearts with sealer/finish. Let dry. Sand lightly.
2. Base coat the hearts with mistletoe. Let dry.
3. With the points of the larger hearts facing down, use the #8 brush to float titanium white down the left side of each heart. Float forest green down the right side and point of each heart.
4. Use the stylus to put 3 white dots on the curve of each heart on the white side. Let dry.
5. Brush on the acrylic finish. Let dry.
6. Fold the ribbon in half and glue it onto the 1" heart with the ends hanging down. Trim the ends on a slant.
7. Glue the hearts onto the 1" heart with the points facing the center.
8. Glue the green stone in the center of the pin, covering the point where the hearts meet.
9. Glue the pin back on the back.
