### Saturday Seminars

# A Homemade Beaded Reindeer

## Materials:

beads (for each reindeer)

6mm faceted root beer:	7
4mm faceted root beer:	41
6mm faceted red:	1
18mm starflake root beer:	6
12mm starflake root beer:	20
10mm starflake root beer:	2

2 brown pipe cleaners (chenille stems)

craft glue

1/8" red ribbon

old scissors or wire cutters

## Instructions:

1. Cut the stems as follows:

legs: 2 pcs each 4" long

body: 1 pc 5" long

antlers: 1 pc 4" long, 2 pcs 2" long

2. Bend the pipe cleaner pieces for the legs in half. String the

beads for each half of the legs: 3 – 12mm starflakes, 1 – 6mm faceted, 4 – 4mm faceted, 1 – 6mm faceted

3. Trim the ends close to the last bead. Pull the last bead off each end. Dip the pipe cleaners in glue and put the beads back on. Set aside for now.

4. Fold the long antler piece in half. String 3 – 4mm faceted beads on each end. Fold the 2 small antler pieces in half. Place glue in the fold of one piece and place the stem next to the last bead on one side of the long antler. Slide 3 – 4mm beads onto the main antler. Repeat with the second side. Slide 3 – 4mm faceted beads onto the small pieces of the antlers. Glue the last beads in place and trim the pipe cleaners. Set aside for now.

5. String the beads for the body:

Starting at the tail, string 1 – 4mm faceted bead and 1 – 6mm faceted bead.

6. Place a small amount of glue in the fold of one set of legs. Lay the fold at the end of the last tail bead.

String 2 – 12mm starflakes and 6 – 18mm starflakes.

7. Place a small amount of glue in the fold of the second set of legs. Lay the fold next to the shoulder end of the body.

8. String 1 – 18mm starflakes and 5 – 12mm starflakes for the neck and start of the head.

9. Place a small amount of glue in the fold of the antlers. Lay the fold next to the head bead. Add 2 – 12mm, and 2 – 10mm starflakes for the head.

10. Add the 6mm red bead for the nose.

11. Tie a 6" piece of 1/8" red ribbon around the reindeer's neck.

Bend the pipe cleaners to position the reindeer how you desire.

To make the reindeer an ornament, tie ribbon to body so that the ornament is balanced.
